HOW IT'S MADE

From the rugged landscape that surrounds the neighboring towns with its clay and limestone sub strata is home to the AOP Languedoc, but the vineyards do not stop with the AOP's geographical limits and it is from these outskirts that this wine derives. The region benefits from the warm Mediterranean sunshine which is tempered by the altitude and cooler nights. This is characteristic of the Pyrenees foothills and ideal for the longer, slower ripening of the grapes, providing a superb base for intensity, complexity and finesse for the traditional 'noble' grape varieties of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

Made from mostly hand-picked grapes, this wine has been vinified in large, old oak barrels which impart texture and intensity.
